7. If you are a gourmet and like to get to know regional flavours, here you can feast like a king, enjoy dishes prepared from locally-grown, organic products and drink wine and beer with a unique taste and aroma, made by local producers.
8. Here you will find places where the time has stopped and handicraft traditions of the old Polish village, menageries and flower gardens are presented to the public. You can meet passionate enthusiasts who try to preserve traditional crafts and trades from falling into oblivion.
9. There are comfortable agritourism farms, guesthouses and modern glamping sites tailored especially to your needs. You can relax among green fields and orchards and enjoy watching plants, birds and domestic animals.
10. You can admire beautiful bird's-eye views from the basket of a hot-air balloon, take a ride in a melex with an English-speaking guide or go on a trip on the retro Narrow Gauge Railway.

Tailor your visit to fit your own preferences, travel style and interests. At any time, you can take a break, have a bite to eat and continue your journey.

THE LAND OF LOESS GORGES

Is an area of unspoiled nature, crystal clear water and clean air. Tourists visiting our region will find here scenic loess hills, in which nature has carved picturesque gorges, sand dunes and plains, large forests and woodland areas, springs, rivers and ponds rich in fish. There are also areas of protected landscape with rare, protected species of plants and animals, and habitats of waterfowl, e.g. grey heron. On the steep banks of the Vistula River Valley, quarries are exposed, in which prehistoric fossils can be discovered.

Tourists can enjoy a well-developed tourist base, kilometres of tourist trails for cycling, hiking and horse riding, numerous educational paths, water trails and ornithological sites. Skiing enthusiasts will also find a place to practice their sports. Guests can relax at the agritourism farms, guesthouses and hotels, taste regional dishes, local wine and organic products. They can also stay at the health resorts to cure their ailments, boost vitality and improve general well-being.

FOR CONNOISSEURS OF ART AND CULTURE

Exploring the natural beauty, traditions and history of the region is as attractive as good food or comfortable accommodation. The past of the region is well documented and exhibited in numerous museums, halls of memory and exhibitions located in palaces and castles. The centuries-old architecture can make you feel like a time traveller and a participant in historic events.



The Princes Czartoryski Residential Complex in Puławy features a park with many historical buildings: **the Temple of the Sibyl, the Gothic House, the Roman Gate, the Greek House, the Yellow House**, as well as grottos, bridges, terraces and park sculptures, which are elements of the original landscape and architectural layout. In the Temple of the Sibyl, modelled on the ancient Temple of Vesta in Tivoli near Rome, Princess Izabela Czartoryska created the first museum in Poland in 1801. She designated the Gothic House for collections of foreign art, which boasted such masterpieces as *'Lady with an Ermine'* by Leonardo da Vinci and *'Landscape with the Good Samaritan'* by Rembrandt van Rijn (currently on display at the National Museum in Krakow).



The Małachowski Palace in Nałęczów, built at the end of the 18th century according to Ferdinand Nax's design by Stanisław Małachowski of the Nałęcz coat of arms, is one of the most significant landmarks in this city. The Old Baths, opened in 1821, are among the oldest health facilities in the Spa Park. Other historical buildings include the so-called **Hydropatia** (currently the Prince Józef Sanatorium), **the Greek House, and the English Villa**. The historical buildings of the spa from the turn of 20th century can be seen while walking along Lipowa Street and Armatnia Góra Street.

The Arian Tower in Wojciechów is a three-storey Gothic-Renaissance building, built from brick and stone in the first half of the 16th century. It served both defensive and residential functions. During the Reformation, it was the seat of the Calvinist congregation. At the beginning of the 17th century, it was transformed into a granary. Currently, the building is used for museum purposes.

The defensive castle in Janowiec, built in the early 16th century and expanded in the following centuries by the architects: Santi Gucci Fiorentino and Tylman van Gameren, was one of the most impressive strongholds of the former Polish-Lithuanian Commonwealth. Destroyed during the Swedish war in 1656, the castle is now a picturesque ruin, with a separate exhibition area and cloisters. There is an open-air museum in the park by the castle with a manor house and farm outbuildings from the second half of the 18th century. **The Castle Museum in Janowiec, Branch of the Nadwiślańskie Museum in Kazimierz Dolny.**

The tower and castle in Kazimierz Dolny

– a complex of fortifications from the 13th and 14th centuries is still a place that can strongly stir the imagination. The castle, built on the orders of King Casimir the Great, has a spacious courtyard, surrounded by a thick and high wall. It was seriously damaged during the Swedish war in 1655 and remained a romantic ruin.

The neighbouring houses of Krzysztof and Mikołaj Przybyła from 1615 in the Main Market Square have arcades, richly decorated attics and decorative ornamentation on the façade. They are regarded as the best-preserved Renaissance townhouses in Poland, while **the townhouse of Bartłomiej Celej**, built before 1635, is considered the most beautiful building of its kind.

The Czartoryski Museum in Puławy, located on the ground floor and two palace floors, hosts exhibitions presenting the most important aspects of the cultural heritage and achievements of the Czartoryski family. During the summer season, the Temple of the Sybil, the Gothic House and the Alexandrian House are open to the public.

The Museum of Blacksmithing in Wojciechów presents a collection of over 1,500 blacksmith artefacts, forge equipment with a hearth, anvil, bellows and traditional blacksmith's tools. In the **Regional Museum** you can see the interior of a peasant's cottage, handicrafts and clothes.

The exhibition presents the authentic equipment, furniture, portraits and valuable personal memorabilia belonging to the writer. ACTIVE RECREATION

Cycling allows you to explore picturesque areas and enjoy nature from a different perspective. You don't have to own a bicycle to set off on the route, as bike rentals are available. The most beautiful cycling trail is the **Rose Trail in Końskowola**, leading through numerous rose plantations in this area



A kayaking trip down the Kurówka River is a great attraction for kayaking enthusiasts. The Kurówka kayaking trail (16 km) starts in Szumowo and ends in Opoka. There are large areas of peat bogs in the river basin. The company Dwa Żywioty rents out various types of water equipment and also organizes kayaking trips down the Kurówka and the Vistula River.

PLACES OF SACRUM

For centuries, people have heightened their sensitivity by visiting places characterized by an undefined feeling of sacrum. They have sought solace and aesthetic impressions, intensified by the artistry of architecture, and often found them in temples and sacred places of worship. Churches can tell a lot about the history of the region, so it is no wonder that thousands of tourists visit them.



The Parish Church of the Finding of the Holy Cross in Końskowola was founded in the 16th century by Andrzej Tęczyński. Inside there is a valuable sarcophagus of Zofia Lubomirska, née Opalińska, by Tylman van Gameren and the only Vanitas sculpture in Poland (Latin: vanity).

The Sanctuary of Our Lady of Kębło in Wąwolnica is the destination of numerous pilgrimages. The object of worship is the medieval figure of Our Lady with Child, who miraculously revealed herself in the town of Kębło during the Tartar invasion in 1278.

The Church of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Puławy was founded by Prince Adam Kazimierz Czartoryski and built according to Christian Piotr Aigner's design, modelled on the Roman Pantheon, in the years 1800-14.

The Church of St. Joseph, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Puławy was built in the years 1725-28. The paintings of the Holy Family and the images of St. Barbara and St. Teresa of Avila were painted by Kazimierz Wojniakowski, a student of Marcello Bacciarelli. Princesses Maria and Zofia Czartoryski posed for the paintings of the saints.

The Loreto House in Gołęb, based on the model of the House of the Holy Family of Nazareth – Santa Casa in Loreto, was founded in 1634 by Jerzy Ossoliński, an esteemed diplomat and politician. The two-storey building was built in the style of Mannerist architecture with elements of Baroque.

POLISH RURAL TRADITIONS

Folk culture is regarded as the common good and spiritual legacy passed down from generation to generation. Visiting places where time stopped in the bygone era is a unique way to discover history and rural traditions of the region. You can see a traditional farmstead, folk art and crafts, and learn about professions that were once popular and now are nearly forgotten.
